We will work on many of these skills by incorporating them into games and activities and by increasing the distractions in the environment. As in previous classes, we'll show you ways to motivate your dog in training and will encourage the use of positive reinforcement to help maintain good behavior.

During **Advanced Training** classes, you'll also be encouraged to reinforce appropriate socialization skills so that your dog continues to have good interactions with other dogs and people. Information about behavior will be shared as situations occur in class and when owners have specific questions. Children and other family members are encouraged to attend class in order to improve their understanding of training and behavior. **SPOT & CO.** instructors believe that dog training is a family activity and that it should be **fun** for you and your dog.
